### RESOLUTION

The **State Marine Accident Investigation Commission** composed of:

Cezary Łuczywek - the Chairman of the SMAIC

Marek Szymankiewicz - the Secretary of the SMAIC

on 5 October 2016 having considered the materials related to the serious marine casualty of a vessel *Sabina* under the Swiss flag, which took place on 19 June 2016 and resulted in the vessel's grounding in the river Oder, in the Mieliński Channel, following a preliminary assessment of the causes of the casualty, concluded that it had been caused by the loss of propulsion brought about by the a damage to the main engine (a rupture of the cylinder lining and a block of the piston). Taking into regard the circumstances of the casualty and the fact that the investigation had been taken by a competent authority on the investigation of maritime accidents in Switzerland, i.e. the *Swiss Transportation Safety Investigation Board* (STSB) the Commission - following Art. 22.1 of the Act of 31 August 2012 on the State Marine Accident Investigation Commission (Journal of Laws of 2012, item 1068 and of 2015, item 1320) - decided to refer the control over the investigation and the collected materials to that authority.
