The **State Marine Accident Investigation Commission** composed of:

on 6 December 2016, having considered the materials related to a very serious marine casualty of a sea-going recreational vessel *Slaggo*, under the Swedish flag, in tow by a fishing boat *Onkel Sam*, under the Danish flag, which took place on 8 July 2016 in the Baltic Sea, ca. 8 Nm to the north of the Port of Darłowo, as a result of which the vessel in tow sank, has decided that sinking was caused by the fact, the vessel had lost buoyancy caused by flooding the vessel with water due to loss of tightness of the wooden plating of the hull.

The Commission recognizes that it is necessary to prepare and publish the final report.
