The **State Marine Accident Investigation Commission** composed of:

Cezary Łuczywek - the Chairman of the SMAIC

Marek Szymankiewicz - the Secretary of the SMAIC

Krzysztof Kuropieska - the Member of the SMAIC

having considered on 12 January 2017 the materials related to a marine casualty aboard a fishing boat *KOL-288* under the Polish flag, which took place on 22 July 2016 in the Port of Kołobrzeg during unloading of the load of fish from the hold, as a result of which 3 crew members and 5 other people were poisoned and required hospitalization, has decided that the casualty had been caused by poisoning with hydrogen sulphide, which emanated in the hold of the boat due to chemical processes taking place in the load of fish.

The Commission has decided to prepare and publish the final report.
