on 5 February 2016, having considered the materials related to the serious marine casualty of a sea-going sailing yacht *Polonus* under the Polish flag, which took place on 22 December 2014 near the H. Arctowski Memorial Polish Arctic Station in the Antarctic, has decided that the yacht had come too close to the coastline in order to anchor in the prevailing unfavorable weather conditions which caused her running aground the rocky coast of the King George Bay.
