**RESOLUTION**

The **State Marine Accident Investigation Commission** composed of:

Cezary Łuczywek - the Chairman of the SMAIC

Marek Szymankiewicz - the Secretary of the SMAIC

Krzysztof Kuropieska - the Member of the SMAIC

on 5 October 2016, having considered the materials related to the serious marine casualty involving sailing yachts *Wiatr I* and *Baltic Star* under the Polish flag, which took place on 17 September 2016 in the Gulf of Gdańsk, near Nowy Port, as a result of which both yachts required assistance from the shore (towing to port), because *Wiatr I* had gone aground, and *Baltic Star* while attempting to help that yacht, had got a line wound up around her propeller, taking into regard the circumstances of the casualty and lack of serious consequences, has decided that the results of the investigation would not prevent similar marine casualties in the future and following Art. 20.2 in relation to Art. 15.2, subparagraph 2, point "c" of the Act of 31 August 2012 on the State Marine Accident Investigation Commission (Journal of Laws of 2012, item 1068, and of 2015, item 1320) has renounced the investigation.
